- 1. Apply on-line to Summer Engineering Internship at http://www.avinc.com/careers. The job # is 14-117.
- 2. Candidates that are selected for the next step will receive an internship questionnaire via email in the Jan. / Feb. 2015 time frame.
 - 4. The completed questionnaires will be reviewed and candidates will be selected for telephone interviews.
- 5. Hiring managers will make decisions and offers will be extended in the April/May time frame.

We look for the following in our intern candidates:

- 1. A GPA of 3.0 or above and a major in any of the following: aerospace engineering, mechanical engineering, electrical engineering, or computer science/software engineering.
- 2. We also look for extra-curricular activities that relate to a student's major or hobbies that pertain to our business such as the Design/Build/Fly competition or RC plane experience. Experience with batteries and/or industrial vehicles as well as an interest in renewable energy is also a plus.
 - 3. Communication skills and the ability to work in a team environment are also important.
