

## 2017 SUMMER INTERNSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. <u>Apply on-line to Summer Engineering Internship, job #16-140, at http://www.avinc.com/careers.</u> Please apply before the end of October 2016.

2. Candidates that are selected for the next step will receive an internship questionnaire via email in the November / December time frame.

3. The completed questionnaires will be reviewed and candidates will be selected for telephone interviews.

4. Hiring managers will make decisions and offers will be extended in the January / February time frame.

## We look for the following in our intern candidates:

1. A GPA of 3.0 or above and a major in any of the following: aerospace engineering, mechanical engineering, electrical engineering or computer science/software engineering.

2. We also look for extra-curricular activities that relate to a student's major or hobbies that pertain to our business such as the Design/Build/Fly competition or RC plane experience. Experience with batteries and / or industrial vehicles as well as an interest in renewable energy is also a plus.

3. Communication skills and the ability to work in a team environment are also important.

## **General information**

We typically hire college juniors and above into our internship program. By college junior, we mean one who has obtained junior level standing in one's major (not overall).
